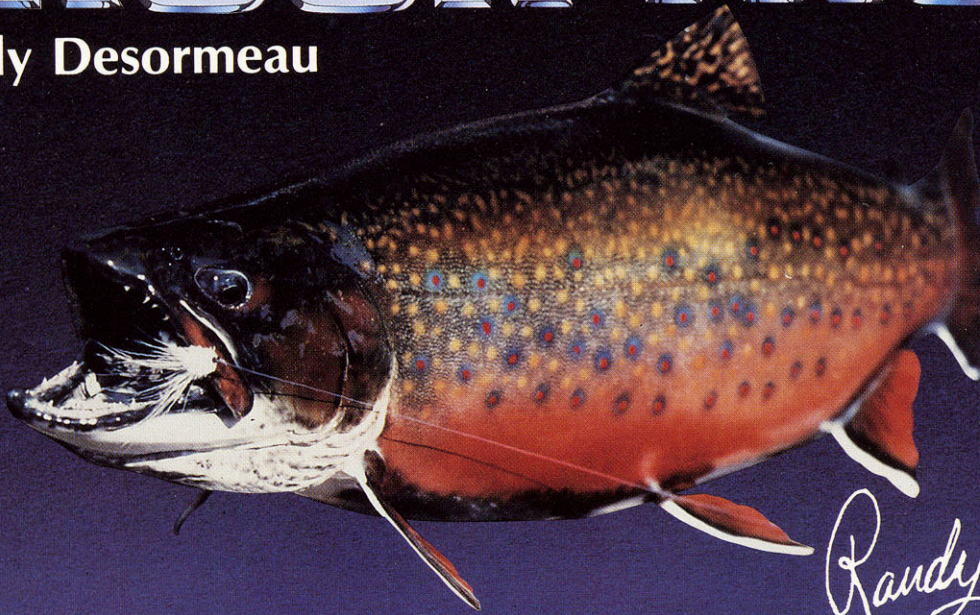

LIFE TONE[®] PAINTING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **REPAIR GRAY**—Mix 2 volumes #601 Jet Black, 2 volumes #203 Dark Brown, and 1 volume #702 Pure White. Use this mixture to paint over repair areas and to even out skin tone.
2. **#100 BASECOAT SEALER**—Seal fish with 1 heavy coat.
3. **#702 PURE WHITE**—Spray mouth, belly, gill covers, lower edge of tail, and leading edges of pelvic, anal, and pectoral fins. (Figure 1)
4. **#302 GOLDEN YELLOW**—Mist center of gill covers and entire side of fish.
5. **HALO BLUE**—Mix 3 volumes #973 White Pearl with 1 volume #501 Ocean Blue and mist lightly over Golden Yellow on gill covers and side of fish. Use this color to paint halos on fish. (Figure 2)
6. **VERMICULATION YELLOW**—Mix 2 volumes #303 Yellow Ochre with 1 volume #703 Ivory White and paint yellow dots and vermiculation pattern just enough to cover. (Figure 3)
7. **#203 DARK BROWN**—Mist back lightly until you can just see the yellow vermiculation.

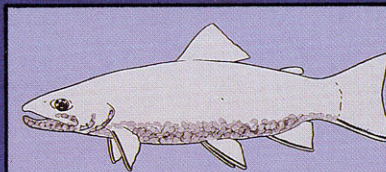

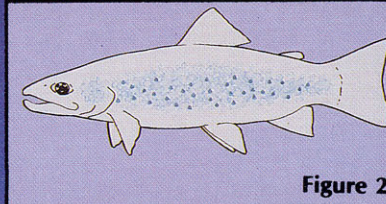

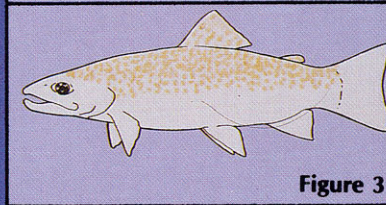

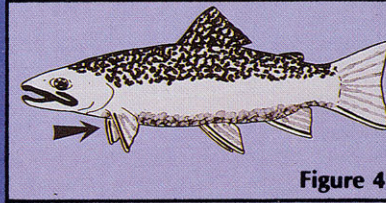

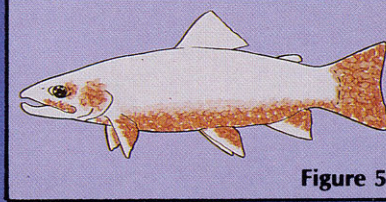

8. **#601 JET BLACK**—Paint all areas between the yellow vermiculation pattern. Very lightly angle spray all fins and tail from front of fish. Spray spawning stripe, inside mouth, maxillary bone, and just behind the white leading edges of pelvic, anal, and pectoral fins. (Figure 4)

9. **#801 VIVID ORANGE**—Spray spawning stripe, lower fins, tail, gill cover, and around eye. (Figure 5)

10. **#452 TRANSPARENT MEDIUM GREEN**—Mist along top of back fading down to upper side.

11. **BROWN TONER**—Mix 1 volume #203 Dark Brown, 5 volumes #500 Gold Toner, and 5 volumes #100 Basecoat Sealer. Use this color to tone down top and side of fish.

12. **HALO BLUE**—Respray halos with Blue-Pearl mixture.

13. **#101 GILL RED**—Spray the red dots in the center of the halos.

14. **#702 PURE WHITE**—Carefully respray leading edges of pelvic, anal, and pectoral fins. Spray lower edge of tail.

15. **SPAWNING RED**—Mix 1 volume #101 Gill Red with 1 volume #105 Red Violet and lightly spray spawning stripe and tail.

16. **#304 WOOD DUCK YELLOW**—Repaint a few of the yellow dots here and there—not all of them! You can also lightly mist a few of the dots on the lower side with Vivid Orange.

17. **LIQUID CRYSTAL™**—Spray 2 coats over entire fish.
