
## **PAINTING INSTRUCTIONS**


- 1. #100 BASECOAT SEALER—Seal entire fish with 2 coats.
- 2. #402 MEDIUM GREEN—Paint top of head to blend with body.
- 3. #702 PURE WHITE—Spray belly and lower jaw allowing spray to mist up side of fish. Spray inside of mouth and areas around eyes and nostrils. (Figure 1)
- 4. #972 SILVER PEARL—Spray over all areas painted white.
- 5. GOLDEN BRONZE—Mix 3 volumes #934 Gold Sparkle with 1 volume #933 Bronze Metallic and mist over back down to lateral line. (Figure 2)
- 6. #971 SILVER METALLIC—Mist very lightly in stripe area, on gill cover, and on cheek below eye.
- 7. #972 SILVER PEARL—Spray over Silver Metallic.
- 8. #303 YELLOW OCHRE—Mist lightly over stripe area, along line where lower fins meet belly, and on all fins. Lightly spray lower mandible and gill cover. (Figure 3)











- 9. #101 GILL RED—Mist lightly over stripe area, gill cover, and lower jaw. #204 Mallard Tan may also be used if a more orange stripe is desired.
- 10. #452 TRANSPARENT MEDIUM GREEN—Spray a light to medium coat on upper back, fading down to lateral line. Spray tail and lower fins.
- 11. #201 RICH BROWN—Mist lightly over areas painted with Transparent Medium Green.
- 12. #911 IRIDESCENT RED—Mist lightly over stripe area, gill cover, and under eye.
- 13. #601 JET BLACK—Paint the irregular spot pattern on fish. Use to shade back to desired color, and to darken mandible and jaw. Lightly mist over belly. (Figure 4)
- 14. #502 DEEP VIOLET—Very lightly mist in area between stripe and lower belly fins.
- 15. #951 IRIDESCENT BLUE—Lightly mist above stripe from eye to tail. Be careful not to apply too much. If you can see it—it's too much! (Figure 5)
- 16. #102 NATURAL FLESH—Spray inside mouth and anal opening.
- 17. GOLD TIPPING PEN—Apply the gold tips or spots on the back above the lateral line. These spots are very sharp and round in shape.
- 18. LIQUID CRYSTAL™—Apply 2 coats and let dry 24 hours.
